Pray that we will have the courage to face recurring sin and lay it at the feet of Jesus, ask for His forgiveness, and then repent.

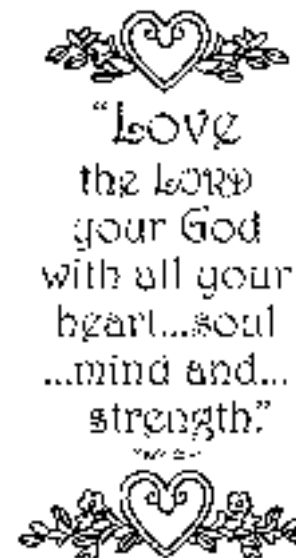
Friday, February 27:
